#### **Introduction**

A new one day classroom based course, which will provide candidates with an introduction to environmental issues on construction sites. It is designed to meet basic environmental knowledge that the sub-contract chain are required to prove to major contractors. It also covers the environmental aspects of the new HS&E touch screen test.

- What the environment is and why it is important
- Outline of environmental management systems
- Waste management
- Pollution prevention and water management
- Good neighbor-statutory nuisance, communication
- Archaeology and heritage

- Delegates should be able to identify possible areas of archaeological or heritage value on construction sites
- Delegates should be able to identify possible areas of environmental practice, in which they could improve
