It is designed to meet basic environmental knowledge that the sub-contract chain are required to prove to major contractors. It also covers the environmental aspects of the new HS&E touch screen test.

- Archaeology and heritage

- Delegates should be able to identify the possible pollution sources, pathways and receptors encountered during work on construction sites
- Delegates should be able to identify possible causes of statutory nuisance on constructions sites
- Delegates should be able to identify possible areas of archaeological or heritage value on construction sites
- Delegates should be able to identify possible areas of environmental practice, in which they could improve
